I. David's Triumphs – (Chapters 1-11)

- David as King of Judah (1-4)
- David as King of Israel (5-11)
- Davidic Covenant (7: 8- 16)
 - Messiah would come from David's lineage
 - Affirmed by Is. 11:1; Jer 23:5; Ezekiel 37:25
- Several significant things about the covenant (Ch. 7)
 - Confirmation of David as King of Israel (v.13)
 - Perpetuation of the David rule (v.11-16)
 - Unconditional because it is fulfilled in Christ
 - This is the fourth prophecy of Christ as Messiah given by the Father
 - 1. Adam – Gen 3:15 – promise to a race
 - 2. Abraham – Gen 22:18 – to a nation
 - 3. Jacob Gen 49:10 – tribe of the nation
 - 4. David – 2 Sam 7:11 – family of the nation
